STATE BUDGET DELIVERING \$36.2 MILLION EXPANSION AT BRABHAM PRIMARY SCHOOL

- \$36.2 million for new multi-level classroom block and education support facility
- Increased classroom capacity to help relieve enrolment pressures
- Funding builds upon McGowan Governments record spend on education in West Swan electorate

The 2022-23 State Budget is delivering a \$36.2 million boost for a new multi-level classroom block and education support facility at Brabham Primary School.

The \$36.2 million boost will enable the planning and construction of education support facilities, an additional multi-level general learning classroom building and an offsite early childhood facility at the school.

The multi-level teaching building will feature state-of-the-art facilities, including 15 general classrooms, science labs, activity areas, offices, and student staff amenities.

The education support services building will include, 4 general classrooms, additional offices and assessments rooms, independent skills room, sensory and low stimulus rooms along with supplementary early learning facilities.

These contemporary facilities will also be accommodated by a physio-gym and specialised pool for education support students in the area.

This funding will ensure the school has the classroom capacity required to meet growing student numbers and provide greater education support facilities for the north-east corridor.

The McGowan Labor Government continues to invest in Western Australian schools, this year's state budget sees a total of almost \$6 billion allocated to Western Australian schools.
