AVELEY BUS SHELTERS – CONSTRUCTION COMMENCES

Today Rita Saffioti, Member for West Swan, announced construction on new bus shelters in Aveley has commenced as a result of her \$100,000 election commitment to the community.

Early 2021 many residents contacted Ms Saffioti's office highlighting the need for additional bus shelters in the area.

As a result of community feedback, Ms Saffioti and the McGowan Labor Government committed \$100,000 to install new bus shelters in Aveley.

Aveley residents were then invited to provide feedback on where they would like to see new bus shelters installed.

The feedback received by residents was overwhelming, residents expressed the greatest community need for bus shelters at the following six locations:

- Stop Number 26144 - Flecker Promenade after Lago Promenade
- Stop Number 26158 - Egerton Dr after Swanleigh Pde
- Stop Number 26143 - Egerton Dr after Wexcombe Way
- Stop Number 26151 - Millhouse Rd after Henley Brook Ave
- Stop Number 26157 - Flecker Promenade before Lago Promenade
- Stop Number 25027 – Gngangara Rd after Henley Brook Ave

Aveley residents will greatly benefit from the implementation of these new bus shelters when complete in the first half of 2022.

"It is important to involve the local community in projects that will benefit them, I would like to thank Aveley residents for their participation in consultation.

"Introducing additional bus shelters at locations chosen by local residents will not only add to amenity, but also provide upgraded infrastructure along major bus routes in Aveley which will soon connect to the much-anticipated METRONET Morley-Ellenbrook Rail Line.
